MINUTES FOR OUR MEETING, SEPTEMBER 29, 2018

1. Sabe a Perú - TV Show

Our Committee was approached by the U.S. Department of Commerce from the U.S. Embassy in Lima, Perú. They have partnered with Movistar, a major telecommunication company in Latin America, that produces a television show called "Sabe a Perú" (Tastes like Perú). Sabe a Perú is a cooking show hosted by renowned Peruvian chef Luciano Mazzetti, who travels all over the world introducing Peruvian cuisine in different markets for one day. The premise of the show is to learn and experience local flavors from restaurants that best represent the essence of the city that Luciano visits. Movistar has selected Austin as their next destination, and they reached out to the Austin-Lima committee for advice.

Tentative, the episode that would be filmed in Austin will take place from October 25th through October 27th. The ALS Committee is assisting Movistar with identifying restaurants that would be interested in being a part of this TV opportunity. ALSC is also gathering information about film permits and cooking-related requirements. To date, the information gathered includes (in Spanish):

Filmación: Durante la filmación en el restaurante anfitrión: no se necesita ningún permiso de filmación, siempre y cuando se filme dentro del restaurante. Para todo tipo de filmación fuera del restaurante (b-roll, o mas de 15 minutos) hay que solicitar permisos. Adjunto esta el formulario guía con todos los requerimientos que tendrían que cumplir el equipo de producción. La aplicación de los permisos tendrían que hacerla ustedes directamente, ya que terceros no pueden aplicar para obtenerla.

Cocina: En cuanto a permisos relacionados con cocinar, nuestro contacto de la Ciudad de Austin dijo que no está segura si van a necesitar alguna tipo de permiso del Departamento de Salud del Condado de Travis. Hemos llamado al número de teléfono que tenemos (512.854.4100) pero aun no responden. Seguimos intentando.

Uso de Drones: La Administración Federal de Aviación (FAA, por sus siglas en Inglés) requiere que el operador del dron esté licenciado por el FAA y que la ruta de vuelo del dron no esté dentro de ningún espacio restringido por la FAA. Entre otros requerimientos para uso de drones con motivos comerciales, el dron debe pesar menos de 55 libras, ser volado a distancia visual, no ser volado sobre aeronaves o sobre personas, ser volados durante el día y por debajo de los 400 pies de altura.

a. SXSW 2018 - Trade Show & Casa Perú

For the first time, Perú took part in the 2018 South By Southwest Trade Show together with a number of entrepreneurs from the tech and innovation sectors. The trade show took place between March 11th & 14th, 2018.

Whilst all operating within the tech sector, the Peruvian start-ups that traveled to Austin belong to a variety of industries including: finance, health, tourism and services. Spacedat, one of several businesses represented at SXSW, offered solutions for monitoring and predicting blueberry harvests; Innova Factory, a FinTech company, facilitates factoring operations in Perú while DROP develops technology for identifying and monitoring skin problems.

Mariella Soldi, Perú's Deputy Director of Nation Branding, said, "Perú comes to SXSW to allow access of Peruvian start-ups to a large network of business contacts and unique investment opportunities. In this way, the Peruvian government supports businesses and provides them with the tools required to generate commercial links with cities, such as Austin, that have a strong tech and innovation sector.




In addition to Perú's participation in the Trade Show, Casa PERÚ opened its doors to provide an ideal opportunity for festival visitors to have a 360 degree experience of what Perú is about today, its culture, gastronomy, music and art, as well as live entertainment and workshops. These activities took place every day between March 9th & 14th, 2018. This initiative was a joint effort by Marca Perú and the Austin-Lima Sister Cities Committee. Casa Perú was located at 84 Rainey Street, Austin, TX 78701.

In 2017, Peruvian start-ups received a 30% boost in investment. 86% of investments came from local sources which is very positive for triggering new ventures. Family offices, venture capital funds and corporations from outside Perú have also increased their investments in entrepreneurial capital.

Meetings and business rounds took place at the Perú Trade Show stand and had visits from a large number of local and international business people and investors, as well as specialist media and press.




















The delegation was part of a 10-day program sponsored by Open World Leadership Center. The delegates started their program with an orientation session in Washington DC, before arriving in Austin on Friday, July 13, 2018. The primary focus of the program was centered on Accountable Governance in the American System.

The congressmen that visited Austin were Vicente Antonio Zeballos Salinas, Marisol Espinoza Cruz, Jorge Melendez Celis, Richard Arce. The group was accompanied by Francesca Varda, a member of the American Embassy in Perú, that served as their Facilitator and Interpreter.

While in Washington, the delegates met with several members of Congress as well

The dance itself has gained a lot of recognition and is one of the most popular traditional dances of Perú.
